

## RENEWABLE ENERGY TOUR TO SWEDEN

In partnership with our ATOI colleagues we offer a Renewable Energy Tour to Sweden. The Tour offers the chance to see a mixture of biomass and municipal waste plants supporting 2 small towns north of Stockholm. You will have the opportunity to see the plants operating, understand the science behind the process, discuss with the local authority benefits accrued to consumers and to visit local farmers supplying Woodstock as fuel and getting back waste for use on fields as fertilizers. In addition, there will be the chance to see local authority transport systems being run on alternative fuel sources.

This tour is offered for organized groups and has no fixed dates. The dates for a tour can be flexible but must be between Monday and Friday. Prices can be quoted on an as required basis and will include return flights, hotel accommodation, meals, luxury coach hire and guide/translator.

Flight route proposed is Stansted . Stockholm via Ryan Air,

### **Day 1**

Depart Stansted at early evening for Stockholm. Transfer to local hotel for evening meal and overnight.

### **Day 2**

Breakfast and check out. Join coach/guide and transfer to Koping to see Renewable Energy Plant supplying power to the grid and producing fuel from biogas for public transport

Lunch and travel to Farm producing biogas and using waste from Renewable energy plant. Transfer to hotel, evening meal and overnight

### **Day 3**

Breakfast and check out. Visit Vasteras where they have built a major biogas plant producing energy and gas for local authority vehicles. The plant uses a combination of municipal waste, agricultural product and slurry from local farms and grease trap waste from the food industry. The waste gas is used for transport fuel and the waste product is spread back on to the fields of the farmers. The plant is a co-operative between the local authority, Energy Company and the farming community. Transfer to hotel and evening meal.

### **Day 4**

Check-out and transfer to airport for departure with Ryan Air Flight 1010 for Stansted 1125.
